to be able to see and to comprehend... our problem is not that we don't know, but that we can't see

- Goal of a sermon
- Christ is real!
- When we see, it gives us power
- Gospel is a flame... if we get close its sparks light us on fire

What does he want us to be able to see?

- Love
  - Height, breadth, length depth... surpasses all knowledge. Paul is not one prone to exaggeration. ... normally says, 'I'm an apostle, you shut up. Here he loses his words...'
  - Paul thinks that until you know that, until you feel it... you can't really grow!
- Power... him who is able to do...
  - Power to overcome temptation... some of you consumed by addiction; bad relationships
  - Power for ministry

- Like unclaimed checks... the money is yours, but you never get it

This is what is meant by “fullness of the Spirit”

This is how he gets glory in the church... by the church being places that know intimately God's love and power and demonstrate that. Through their worship, and through their kindness.
